Pine Ridge is the eighth-largest reservation in the United States and is the poorest in the country. It is the site of several events that marked tragic milestones, including the Wounded Knee massacre in 1890 and an armed confrontation in 1975. The population of Pine Ridge suffer numerous severe health conditions and experience very high unemployment rates.
