Dan & Sandy Winkelman are AGWM missionaries to the nation of Burma also known as Myanmar. It is the heart of Buddhism where 90% have never heard the Gospel and only 4% are Christian. Dan is an ordained minister with the Assemblies of God and was senior pastor at Highland Church in Stevens Point, Wisconsin, for over 10 years until he was called to the mission field. Dan has traveled extensively around the world doing leadership training and short term missions. Dan & Sandy currently live in Yangon, Myanmar, and lead the Burma Project which is a church planting movement in that nation.
