Each year, Springtime makes a powerful statement around the

world. God created the world with a built-in need to grow and reproduce. Spring is a time when nature accelerates with new life.

While I am not much of a gardener, I do know that there are three general laws of the garden:

Law 1: The purpose of life is to bear fruit. In John 15:16 we read "I chose you and appointed you to go and bear fruit – fruit that will last." In many

places in the Bible, life is compared to a garden, and in each instance we learn that the purpose of the garden is to produce fruit. How frustrating it would be to till the soil, plant the seeds, tend and water them, weed the garden and then have no return. God's plan is that our lives produce fruit that lasts forever. Fruit bearing is God's life plan for you.

Law 2: A plant is recognized by its fruit. In Luke 6:43-44 we read that "No good tree bears bad fruit, nor does a bad tree bear good fruit. Each tree is recognized by its own fruit." I'm reminded of the old saying that "you can't fool mother nature." A sour apple tree produces sour apples. A thorn bush produces prickly thorns. A sweet peach tree produces sweet peaches. In the same way, sour people with negative attitudes are

drawing that bitterness from deep within. Prickly people who wound others with harsh and piercing words and badactions are tempered because they draw from a belligerent source. People who exude love and grace draw that sweetness from a source deep inside. People are known by their deeds.

Law 3: A fruitless plant is a worthless

weed. Read Luke 13:5-7 and you'll see that there is no room in God's garden for fruitless Christians. In the end, all fruitlessness is judged and discarded. 2 Corinthians 5:10 tells us that everything we do on this earth will be evaluated by Jesus and either rewarded or discarded. It's not meant to be a threat as much as it is an encouragement so that you might build your life with the right things.

So the point of life is fruitfulness, and a fruitful life is one rich in good deeds and pure speech that arises from Christ that results in spreading the gospel and glory of God.
