Knowledge is Power and Relationships are Power-full

Recently a young couple signed up for our new Earn While You Learn (EWYL) program following their ultrasound appointment. They were excited about starting the classes because, as first time parents, they needed to learn all they could, additionally commenting, "There's no way we can afford to pay for prenatal classes. This is great that you offer them for free!"

The Earn While You Learn program is an established DVD/worksheet-based curriculum that provides a holistic approach to pregnancy and parenthood. LaVie was able to purchase the EWYL program through a grant from the Gianforte Family Foundation.

We have found that clients are asking to learn more about specific topics. Some of the requests for additional topics are coming from the dads-to-be, which is supporting a future phase of providing lessons specifically in support of fathers. These lessons will not only focus on fatherhood, but also on manhood and the importance of a man's role in society and in the life of their child.

Our immediate next phase is to implement lesson facilitators. Facilitators will allow a more robust implementa-

tion of the initial phase by using the discussion worksheets to reinforce learning, and really building a supportive relationship with our clients, a relationship most lack in their lives. It is our hope that our clients feel encouragement from the facilitators by developing a relationship that aids in learning, healing and empowerment.



We believe that knowledge is power and relationships are power-full. The extensive education and resources that are provided through the EWYL program can provide a platform for both knowledge and relationships to be added to the lives of our clients, thus creating the empowerment women need to become the moms they desire and hope to be and potentially enriching their lives in a way they've never known.

"We don't talk about religion or politics." When we say abortion is political, we cheapen it, relegating it into the same dustbin of taxes, foreign policy, and deficit spending. Churches who claim abortion is political have an excuse to avoid it..."

Regardless of the world's view on abortion, all of us working and volunteering at LaVie are not motivated by what's going on in Washington D.C. or Helena, Montana. We are energized by what is going on in our own backyard. Those who come through the doors of LaVie, seeking hope in their very broken circumstances, serve as our motivation. We are encouraged by the decision of one of our recent patients to cancel her

surgical abortion appointment. She is carrying twins! Praise God!

No, we don't wake up each day expecting the government will fix the problem of abortion. We get up, ready to serve those in need because God has called us to do so, and with His help and yours, we are making a difference in our community.



Brooklee's Story, Year 2014

Hear directly from Brooklee and baby Ayden on how they are doing now at this year's upcoming banquet (September 28th).

My heart was pounding as I waited those three agonizing minutes. Three minutes, that is all it took for that pink line to appear and turn my world upside down. I was pregnant. I am only 16, I thought to myself, how would I do this on my own, I just can't have a baby.

My name is Brooklee. I would like to introduce you to my son, Ayden. I am so thankful to YOU for this little guy and let me tell you why:

I was distraught with finding out I was pregnant. I needed to have an abortion, I had no choice. I lived in a Christian home, and knew abortion was immoral, but the father of the baby told me I could not keep my child. He was so adamant about it he was pulling out money to pay for the abortion. I was stuck, and went ahead and scheduled the abortion.

Something drew me to LaVie; everyone was so kind and friendly. I thought I would just be going in to get the confirmation of pregnancy, and the paperwork I needed so I could go get the abortion, but something changed in my heart when they flipped on the ultrasound's television. The baby's little heart was pumping so fast, almost as if it was fighting for its own life. At only 5 weeks and 5 days it looked so real. I felt like I was in a movie. Their prayers over me gave me strength to tell my Mom and bring her with me to another ultrasound. As I watched my Mom cry tears of joy when she saw the baby, I realized then how important

it was for me to be the mother to my child. My determination to be a mother and give life to my baby impacted the father and his family; they began to see it as a life as well.

If I had not walked through the doors of LaVie, I wouldn't be holding my baby right now. I wouldn't be able to share my story with YOU. I thank the Lord every single day for making that one decision that saved my son's life. I could never have imagined the feelings I have. I have never been so in love with someone so little before. The Staff at LaVie are Ayden's super heroes! Thanks to the love and support of this ministry, I have the chance to be a mother and not a statistic.
