

## A Patient Story by Jeanne, Our Lead Receptionist

Fear is a liar! It twists things around in our minds until up seems down, black looks white and what once was wrong now feels okay. This is where we met Addison.

\*Addison ... a sweet young lady, mild tempered with a beautiful smile, even though fear had a grip on her. Addison was pregnant and fearful; afraid of telling her parents she is pregnant, afraid of not having enough time and money to support a baby, afraid in general of not being enough.
