COURSE NO. 1038 - THE SURVEY OF PROVERBS

Rev. Earl Bryant, Wildewood Baptist Church – Instructor

Course Description: This course is a collection of moral and philosophical presentations with a broad array of subjects presented in poetic form. This book of Proverbs springs from human experience and preserves many of Solomon's sayings.

COURSE NO. 1075 - THE SYNOPTIC GOSPELS

Rev. Lee Benson, Edmond, OK – Instructor

<u>Course Description</u>: This course will focus on the Synoptic Gospels – Matthew, Mark, and Luke. Students will study the life and ministry of Jesus Christ as portrayed by these three writers. Through this comparative study, students will gain a more comprehensive understanding of Jesus' ministry. <u>Textbook: The Synoptic Gospel; Nickle</u>

COURSE NO. 1079 - SURVEY OF JOHN

<u>Course Description</u>: This course will focus on the fourth Gospel and its uniqueness. Students will identify the specific features that characterize John's gospel and that distinguish it from the Synoptic Gospels, with emphasis on John's writing and the ministry of Jesus Christ.

COURSE NO. 1081 – THE TEACHINGS OF JESUS

COURSE NO. 1089 - SURVEY OF ROMANS

Course Description: This course will focus on a thematic overview of major issues presented in Paul's doctrinal letter to the Roman Christians. Students will come to recognize each doctrinal truth presented in the book.
