ADULT COURSE OFFERINGS

<u>Course No. 1001 – Introduction to the Bible</u> – Sis. Iris Copeland, Pilgrims Baptist Church, Tatums, OK - Instructor

<u>Course Description:</u> This course introduces the student to the Bible as a whole. Students will be exposed to a comprehensive analysis of the 66 books of the Bible.

<u>Course No. 1072 – Introduction to The New Testament</u> – Bro. Robert Simmons, Fairview Missionary Baptist, Oklahoma City, OK – Instructor

<u>Course Description:</u> This course will survey the New Testament. Included in this survey will be a general overview of the divisions, time periods, places, events, people, and archaeology of the New Testament sections of the Bible.
