## COURSE NO. 1038 – SURVEY OF PROVERBS

Rev. Earl Bryant, Wildewood Baptist Church – Instructor

**Course Description**: This course is a collection of moral and philosophical presentations with a broad array of subjects presented in poetic form. This book of Proverbs springs from human experience and preserves many of Solomon's sayings.

## COURSE NO. 1072 – Introduction to The New Testament

## COURSE NO. 1079 - SURVEY OF JOHN
