## **COURSE OFFERINGS AND DESCRIPTIONS**

<u>Course No. 1079 – Survey of John</u> – Rev. Arthur Crawford, Instructor

<u>Course Description</u>: This course will focus on the fourth Gospel and its uniqueness. Students will identify the specific features that characterize John's gospel and that distinguish it from the Synoptic Gospels, with emphasis on John's writing and the ministry of Jesus Christ.

Course No. 2015 – Foundations of Christian Ethics – Rev. Derrick E. Walter, Sr., Instructor

<u>Course Description</u>: This course will focus on understanding the philosophical and Christological approaches to Christian ethics. Engage in biblical principles for decision making and conduct for living.

**Course No. 4012 — Doctrine of the Holy Spirit —** Sis. Jo A. Reed, Instructor

<u>Course Description</u>: This course will focus on the person and work of the Holy Spirit. It will include a thorough look at the corresponding doctrines that impact our understanding of the work of the Holy Spirit. Students will be able to clearly identify this doctrine of the church with holistic understanding of salvation, and with special emphasis on justification, redemption, and sanctification.

Course No. 8066 - Christianity and Contemporary Issues - Sis. Marcy Turner, Instructor

<u>Course Description</u>: This course challenges the students to identify and confront contemporary issues. The students will look at the issues that affect the church, home, and community. They will be encouraged to think of practical solutions and approaches to immediate and emerging social and ecclesiological concerns.

<u>Course No. 9024 – The Computer in the Life of the Church</u> – Sis. Maeleatha Patterson & Bro. Jamar Patterson, Instructors

<u>Course Description</u>: This course is designed to train pastors, office workers, Christian educators, and others who want to utilize computer technology in the church. During this session, the instructor will present techniques and measures, through use of technology, to aid in moving the church forward in the "New Normal." Students will engage in activities to evaluate their individual church Ministries and outline effective processes that may be utilized to re-build, re-connect and re-engage the church and its membership, embracing all persons, regardless of their preferred worship setting, and resulting in church growth and active participation in the work of the Ministry.
