Participant Criteria:

- Saved
- Must be between the ages of 18 35
- Must be active in their local church and Women's Ministry
- Must be able to commit to participating with the Young Adult Ministry the balance of the Associational Year
- Must be able to perform in the talent section of the pageant
- Must have not won the EZCDA Young Adults Queen's Review title in the past 3 year.

Participants will be judged on the following:

- 25 points = Introduction (Presence and poise, knowledge of favorite scripture and originality)
 - Introduction should include your favorite scripture and why. It should not include your church home or your Pastor's name, your parent's name or your last name.
- 25 points = Talent (5 minute time limit)
- 50 points = Question/Answer (Did the participant answer the question? Did they stay within the allowed time frame – 3 minute time limit)
- There will be 10 points deducted from each category automatically if you go over the allotted time frame.
- Bonus Points: 7 points will be added to total score for every meeting/activity attended, not exceeding 21 points. Activities include EZDA Women's, Young Adults and Youth.

Attire:

Introduction ~White suit/dress

- Talent ~ Appropriate attire
- Question/Answer ~ Formal attire

Each participant should have an escort for the Introduction and Question/Answer section of the pageant.
