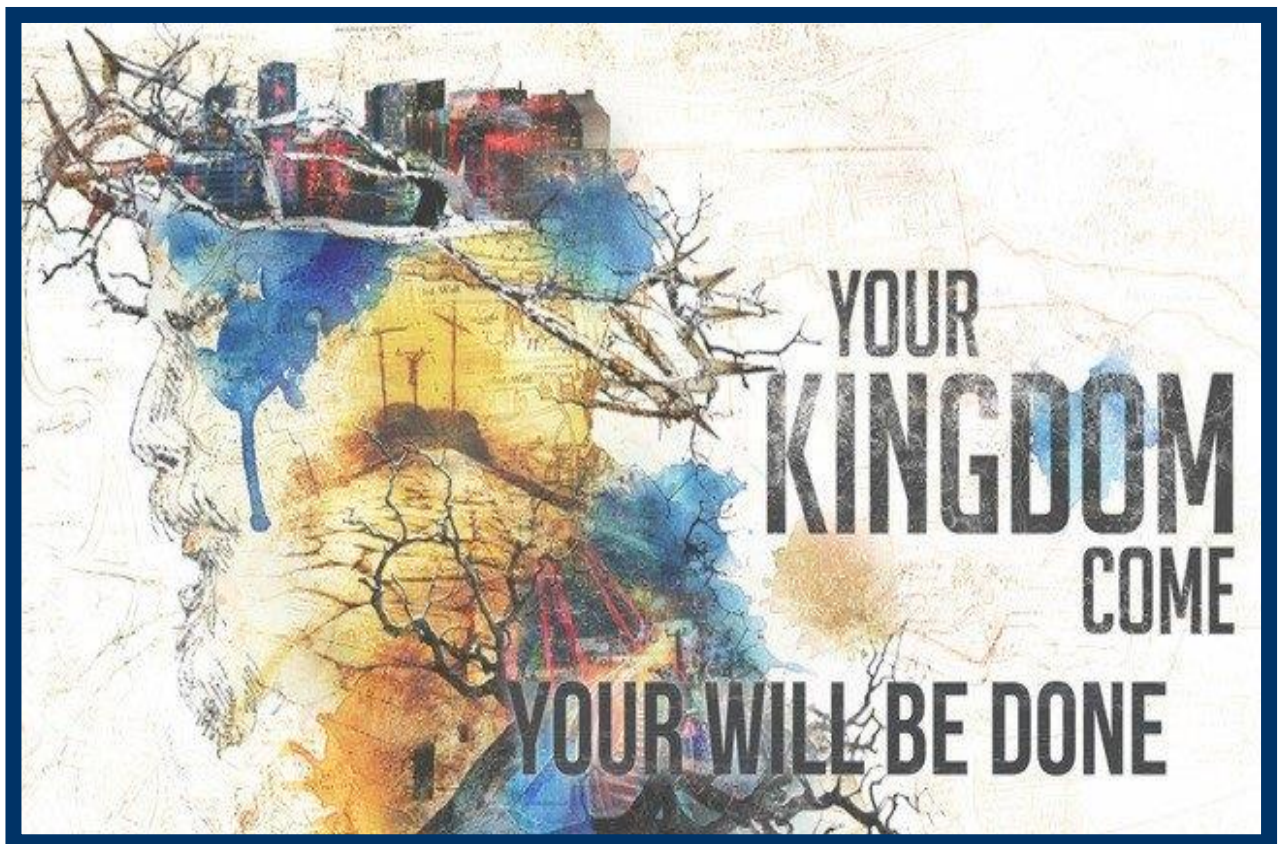

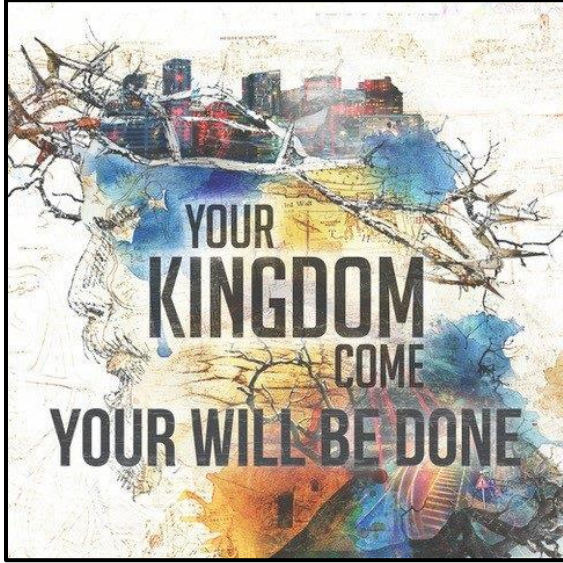

PURPOSE OF OUR GATHERING

The major initiative from this statewide gathering is to illustrate the elements of the kingdom of God in worship through preaching, teaching, fellowship, and equipping. Os Guinness stated, “Jesus made clear that the Kingdom of God is organic and not organizational. It grows like a seed and it works like leaven: secretly, invisibly, surprisingly, and irresistibly”. Certainly, this

is a correct statement, but the invisible kingdom of God becomes visible as the church expresses the character of the King which will flow from, as Paul states to the Colossians, “***To them God willed to make known what are the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles: which is Christ in you, the hope of glory***” (Colossians 1:27, NKJV).

We gather for Him to make Himself known to us in worship through preaching, teaching, fellowship and equipping. His manifest presence provides the opportunity for our personal transformation from a dry, stale or lifeless church to the living, breathing, serving expression of Christ in life. Hence, “***thy kingdom come...***”. Churches are not the kingdom of God but are primary and inevitable expressions of the kingdom. They are outposts, and instrumentalities of the kingdom among us. They are communities of Christ. Jesus proclaimed the Kingdom of God and what came out of that preaching was the Church. As we declare the kingdom, the church will be built by Christ.
