The major initiative of this statewide gathering is to illustrate the elements of the kingdom of God in worship through preaching, teaching, fellowship, and equipping. Os Guinness stated, "Jesus made clear that the Kingdom of God is organic and not organizational. It grows like a seed and it works like leaven: secretly, invisibly, surprisingly, and irresistibly". Certainly, this is a correct statement, but the invisible kingdom of God becomes visible as the church expresses the character of the King which will flow from, as Paul states to the Colossians, "To them God willed to make known what are the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles: which is Christ in you, the hope of glory" (Colossians 1:27, NKJV).

We are gathered to declare to our Father in Heaven...Your kingdom come, Your will be done in us, then declare, by our life, His kingdom through us over Florida.


