Greetings From the Office of the Overseer...

In 2 Peter 3:9 the Apostle Peter says this.

"The Lord is not slack concerning his promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to usward, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance."

God loves us. His whole desire is that we be reconciled to him in the fullness of love and fellowship. He desires to give us **the gift of eternal life**.

In the verse we just read, the Apostle Peter refers to the children of God as "beloved".

Back in the first part of this chapter, he tells them that he is trying to "*stir up their pure minds* by way of remembrance".

And then we see him trying to excite their minds, to the basics of their faith. **He's re-opening their thinking processes** and reminding them of a time when they enjoyed 'purity of mind'.

And to do this, he wants them to **RE-THINK some of the basic truths.** To rethink some of the things they already know.

So he directs them back, in their thinking, to what the prophets of old have said. Then, he points them to the present, to what the Apostles are now saying.

He wants them to look at those things that are commonly known and held among them to be eternal truths. Because therein lies **the life** their souls long for.

The central emphasis of his writing in this passage is the understanding that's found in verse 9 where it clearly says, "it's not God's will that any should perish".

But it's also true that - many will PERISH!!!

Thru-out the Bible we hear phrases that use words like

- ★ Those that are LOST
- ★ Those that PERISH
- **★** ETERNAL DAMNATION
- \* NAMES being blotted out of the Lambs Book of Life
- **★** The SECOND DEATH

The word **perish** actually comes from the Greek word "apollumi" (ap-ol'-loo-mee); it means, "To destroy fully, either literally or figuratively".

Nobody wants this to happen to anyone they care about, and especially not to themselves. To be lost or utterly perish is a serious concern. It's so important that Jesus specifically addresses the reality for those that perish in Matthew chapter 5 verses 29 & 30. Jesus is quoted telling his disciples,

"And if thy right eye offend thee, pluck it out, and cast it from thee: for it is profitable for thee that one of thy members should perish, and not that thy whole body should be cast into hell. And if thy right hand offend thee, cut if off, and cast it from thee: for it is profitable for thee that one of thy members should perish, and not that thy whole body should be cast into hell.

Throughout God's word, we're told time and time again to be very careful. It's clear that even God sees reason for great concern.

God has taken extraordinary efforts to provide deliverance for all of us. He's gone to great lengths to insure that we are not deceived in our journey. God simply doesn't want anyone to perish.

In 2 Samuel 14:14, the prophet says this;

"For we must needs die, and are as water spilt on the ground, which cannot be gathered up again; neither doth God respect any person: yet doth he devise means, that his banished be not expelled from him."

God had devised a means thru which we can be spared.

Many have already perished. Even this very day there have been many that have opened their eyes in that great reservoir where those that perish go.

There will be many that will perish before tomorrow morning. But it doesn't have to be you and it doesn't have to be me. . . .

God has made a way for us to be redeemed. In Acts 2:21, the Bible tells us, "21 And it shall come to pass, that whosoever shall call on the name of the Lord shall be saved.

Please don't be fooled. And please, don't let the lies of Satan distract you.

Look at what you could have and consider.

What is your soul worth? In Matthew 16:26, Jesus asked his disciples, <sup>26</sup> For what is a man profited, if he shall gain the whole world, and lose his own soul? or what shall a man give in exchange for his soul.

That's the one thing that you actually have a say in, with regards to its eternal resting place. It's the most valuable one item you have or will ever have, your own soul.

Think about it. . . . . Paul said, in Romans 10:9, <sup>9</sup>That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. <sup>10</sup>For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.

Redemption is right there, within your reach. Reach out and call on him today. He has promised that He will not turn you away.
