- Care must be given that our actions do not cause others to stumble.
- When someone offends us we should admonish and if he repents, then forgive him.
- When the matter cannot be resolved privately, then (Matt. 18: 15-17) must be employed.
- What's the difference between: sin, trespass, and transgression?
- Forgiving 7 times or 7x70 is a hyperbole to mean we should not keep a record of wrongs committed against us.
- Why did the apostles request an increase in faith?
- Why is forgiveness necessary?

Faithfulness: 7-10

V9. Should a servant receive special commendations for doing what is expected? Explain

V10. Unprofitable means without need, or no one owes us anything.

Thankfulness: 11-10

- There were 10 lepers all 10 were healed, but only one expressed thankfulness.
- Why did Jesus tell the lepers to go show themselves to the priest? (V140)
- The lepers were cleansed on their way to the priest, but the Samaritan turned back and expressed his gratitude.
- Jesus asked where were the other 9 who were healed.
- The Samaritan fell down and thanked Jesus, and Jesus not only healed him physically, but the Samaritan was made whole. (19)

V20. What does it mean "the kingdom of God cometh not with observation."?

V26 & 32. Jesus illustrates the certainty and suddenness of His coming by using two (2) Old Testament events. How does Noah and Lot's wife relate the Second Coming of Christ?
