- (c) What are the best indicators of college success? Include discussion of how your current skills prepare you for success in college and life.
  - 5. Selection of the award recipients will be based on the following criteria:
- (a) Academics
- (b) Community service/volunteerism
- (c) Essay/Video
- (d) Leadership skills
- (e) Demonstrated financial need
