Author: Paul

To Whom Written: The churches in southern Galatia founded on Paul's first missionary journey (including Inconium, Lystra, Derbe), and Christians everywhere.

Purpose: To refute the Judaziers (who taught that Gentile believers must obey the Jew law in order to be saved), and to call Christians to faith and freedom in Christ.

Date written: About A.D 49, from Antioch prior to the Jerusalem council (A.D. 50)
