

PASTOR JAYMES R. MOONEY



Elder Jaymes R. Mooney is a native of Nashville, Tennessee and serves as the Pastor of the Historic Saint Bartley Primitive Baptist Church in Huntsville, Alabama. As a pastor and preacher, Elder Mooney's passion is to serve God by lovingly leading His people into a deeper relationship with Christ. From 2013-2017, Pastor Mooney served as the Senior Pastor of New Bethel Primitive Baptist Church of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, which experienced significant growth both spiritually and numerically.

He led the congregation to capital improvements to the church's sanctuary and created community-centered projects such as a Summer Math and Literacy Program that ministered to over a hundred students in the Fort Lauderdale Community through free tutoring and meals. A lover of learning, Pastor Mooney is a product of the Davidson County School System and Trevecca Nazarene University in Nashville, Tennessee. He is currently pursuing his Master of Divinity from Midwestern Baptist Theological Seminary.
