

Reverend Dr. Keith L. Reynolds Bio



Rev. Dr. Keith L. Reynolds is a native of Gary, Indiana. In 1981 he accepted God's call to the Christian Ministry and preach the Gospel of Jesus Christ. He preached his first sermon at Union Baptist Church in Atlanta under Pastor Rev. J, A. Wilborn. Pastor Reynolds has worked in various ministries from Sunday School Teacher, Vacation Bible Director, Summer Camp Program Director and other youth programs. Pastor Reynolds has also provided worship services for Senior residents in facilities for the aged within Atlanta. Pastor Reynolds has worked in the Atlanta Christian Cursillo movement, which is a non-denominational ministry for both clergy and lay persons. From 1985 to 1995, he worked in the Kairos Prison Ministry which shares the gospel with men who are incarcerated. In 2008 he became the Interim Pastor of Christian Fellowship Baptist Church and was elected Pastor in 2011. Currently he serves as the President of the Association of Christian Ministers of Clayton County and is a member of the leadership team for the Atlanta Metro Baptist Association. Pastor Reynolds is a retired teacher and Principal from the DeKalb School District with over thirty-two years of service in the noble profession of education.

Pastor Reynolds holds a Bachelor of Science Degree from Lincoln University of Missouri, a Masters of Arts Degree from Atlanta University (now Clark Atlanta University), an Education Specialist Degree from Jacksonville State University in Alabama and a Doctorate in Educational Leadership and Supervision from Clark Atlanta University. He has received a Certificate of Theology from the Interdenominational Theological Center in Atlanta.
