

Impact

A tsunami of positive change has swept over the Portage Township YMCA during the past 18 months. We're excited to announce the following accomplishments:

- Resurrection of our Aquatics program. By partnering with local hotels, we can access pools that allow us to teach children safety around water and swim lessons to help prevent drowning. We also teach AquaZumba to adults.
- Addition of new equipment. A grant helped us install new weight machines
 designed for adults with limited mobility and balance. We also added new
 water rowers and stair climbers. Members have enjoyed the therapeutic
 effects of our new infrared sauna and our two new water massage tables.
- <u>Nutrition Kitchen</u>. In February 2019, we opened the Y's Nutrition Kitchen
 to serve up healthy shakes and bars packed with plant-based protein. The
 community will soon have access to educational workshops focused on
 practical skills like cooking demonstrations, meal planning workshops,
 expert lectures, and more.
- Healthy meals and snacks. Children enrolled in our Y-Care afterschool care and Summer Camp programs are served FREE meals that meet the USDA's strict nutritional requirements. Our food costs have skyrocketed by over 4,000%, but thanks to a grant and federal food program, we can afford to serve these higher quality meals.
- Expanded Preschool. We're saying YES to sports, YES to 5-day preschool, YES to 2-year-old preschool, and NO to screens. Our preschool academy is 40 years old and getting better every year.
- New activities for Seniors. Active older adults are taking monthly trips, playing bags, and learning new things at free luncheons.
- Organization of Youth & Adult Sports. Under the leadership of our new Sports Coordinator, our youth & adult sports is picking up great momentum with new season times, fresh ideas, and the implementation of character development.
