The Gift Of A Shoebox

The past several years we have participated in a national ministry outreach movement known as Operation Christmas Child. Through our generous participation, we are truly making an eternal impact. Since 1993, Samaritan's Purse has distributed over 157 million shoebox gifts to impoverished children around the world in Jesus' Name, through the efforts of people, organizations and churches like ours. This year WWCC contributed 69 shoebox gifts! This exceeds our total from last year! Great job WWCC! The most exciting part of this outreach is that these gifts are about more than just providing a Christmas gift to children who otherwise might not get anything for Christmas, more importantly they are fulfilling the Great Commission of Jesus, in sharing the Good News of salvation in Jesus Christ. Once each box leaves our community they make their way to a distribution center where inside each box, a booklet is placed that teaches about Jesus, in the native language of the child that will receive it.

In addition, many of these children who receive a box, also have the opportunity to participate in a 12-lesson discipleship program called, "The Greatest Journey," where they learn what it means to follow Jesus and share their faith with friends and family. In 2017, for every 100 shoeboxes distributed, 16 children reported decisions for Christ through, "The Greatest Journey." That's 1.9 million children - that's the eternal impact of a simple shoebox!

Thank you for your continued generosity and commitment to being the hands and feet of Christ, proclaiming the Good News and the amazing grace of God, locally and globally!
