Moving Toward Life That Is Truly Life

We recently concluded a Sunday morning teaching series on the subject of generosity, which carried with it the tag line, "Moving toward life that is truly life." In this series we learned or were reminded that generosity is about living a generous life in every area of our lives, because not only is it the way to experience a better life and more of the abundant life that Jesus offers, but it is also the life that Jesus Himself modeled and commands us to live. As followers of Christ we ought to have a different value system, which motivates us to make wise and strategic investments that have an eternal impact. We must understand that God blesses us so that we can bless others and that we can pour out our blessings joyfully and without fear, because our God is a God of unlimited refills.

On a regular basis here at WWCC we see evidence that there are many people amongst us who have committed to living generous lives and are continuing to grow in this practice. These generous lives are on display in the way these people give financially, serve selflessly and sacrifice their own personal desires. If you are among those who are living generously in our church and community, THANK YOU. Thank you for strategically investing in eternity and as a result storing up for yourselves treasures in Heaven.

Throughout any given year, generous people are making any number of outreach opportunities possible, in addition to the regular giving of tithes and mission offerings. During Christmas, we again filled a day's worth of slots ringing a bell in support of the community assistance provided by the Salvation Army. During the time we rang the bell, we collected \$345.73, contributing to a total of more than \$80,000! These funds raised through this campaign provided 265 families, including 496 children and 73 senior citizens, with toys, gifts, clothing and food at Christmastime and will continue to provide hundreds of more people with emergency services such as rental/mortgage assistance, utility assistance and food throughout the year. At our annual "Souper" Bowl, a time of fellowship, good eating and friendly competition, over \$600 was given, which I believe is more than any previous year. These funds will enable a group of high schoolers to attend a fantastic Christ In Youth (CIY) conference this summer, where they will be drawn nearer to the heart of God. For the past month many of us have been collecting spare change in baby bottles in support of the life defending and hope giving ministry of Comfort Care Women's Health. As I write this, WWCC has filled 54 baby bottles so far, with several more that will hopefully be turned in within the next week. **If you have not turned in your Comfort Care baby bottle(s) (full or empty), please do so ASAP.**

I could go on and on about all the ways that as a church we are making a difference by choosing to live generously, but I don't have the space to do that, so I will conclude by again saying thank you. Please, do not let the world or even well-meaning, but misguided Christians discourage you or convince you that generosity doesn't matter. Generosity does matter and it does make a huge difference.

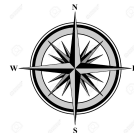
