Seating:

Cornerstone or Stumbling Stone?

1 Peter 2:4-8

Your life will stand or fall based on what you do with Jesus Christ.

Two (and only two) responses & outcomes...

I. To those who believe, Jesus is a cornerstone (4-6)

A. Remember who He is (4, 6)

B. Remember (and be!) who we are (5)

II. To those who disbelieve, Jesus is a stumbling stone (7-8)
