Mia Grace Kennedy has been on King of Glory's prayer concern list since 2015. Her parents are friends of KOG members Blake and Stephanie Stokke. Many people have wondered what her story is and how they can help. The following should answer some of these questions.

Mia was born on January 8, 2015 to David and Lisa Kennedy. During her 20-week ultrasound, it was discovered that Mia would be born without kidneys which would hinder the development of her lungs. The Kennedys decided to go through with the pregnancy and place Mia's life in God's hands.

After her birth, it was discovered that Mia had 1/3 of a kidney and holes in her lungs. She was not expected to live long once taken off life support, but God took over. The holes in Mia's lungs began to close, her kidney began to work a bit, and Mia became more and more alert. Mia and her parents were life-flighted to Denver Children's Hospital and the rest of her incredible journey began. During the past 3 years, Mia has undergone now nightly dialysis, a g-tube placement, cochlear implant, heart surgery, countless doctor visits, close calls, and ambulance rides to save her life.

On May 22nd Mia is scheduled to receive a new kidney from her aunt, who is a perfect match! A new kidney for Mia will mean the end of the nightly dialysis routine and hopefully a decrease in hospital visits. Her fight is far from over, but with the continued prayers and God's help, her outlook looks bright.


