



SUMMER GREETINGS! On behalf of your Board of Directors comes this message: as you make plans for your family's vacation and other activities, please remember to include worshipping with us during the summer months. We also encourage you to participate in the various programs and ministries that are being offered. Few opportunities are more refreshing than to greet friends and visitors, to hear God's word, and find a few moments of peace and quiet within our worship space. As you travel, relax, enjoy your own back yard or our city's parks and recreation areas, we encourage you to remember King of Glory! Your financial contributions make our programs and ministries possible and help us meet financial obligations to our pastors and staff, plus allowing us to pay our bills and keep our building and grounds presentable.

Overall giving appears to be ahead of budget, however, this number includes special designated offerings for the Youth Gathering in Houston, making KOG net income approximately \$12k behind budget. We currently still have a line of credit balance of \$11,650, which is carried over from 2017. The LOC has an interest rate of 4.75%. Based on our current financials, we have delayed our monthly benevolence payments to the ELCA Synod for the months of March, April, and May.

King of Glory Blood Drive - Friday, June 22

On Friday, June 22, King of Glory is sponsoring a blood drive. Appointment slots will be between 2:30 and 6:00. The most recent blood drive at King of Glory was April 27 – that was 8 weeks prior to June 22, and anyone who has not donated red blood cells since that date is eligible to donate on June 22. Your donation will take a little more than an hour, a little less if you take advantage of the Fast Track Health History at home prior to your donation (Future communications will help you with the Fast Track Health History).

This will be the fourth blood drive at King of Glory. The first two were held last year, and all appointment slots were filled. Our April 27 blood drive slots were not nearly so well filled — only a little more than half; I'm hoping/planning to fill our appointment slots again up to the standards we set in our first two blood drives. Watch for the signup sheet on the bulletin board on the west wall of the Commons around June 3. Getting your name on the signup sheet early helps guarantee you get the slot that fits your schedule best.

There is always a need for blood, and only volunteer donors can fulfill that need for patients in our community. Every 2 seconds, someone needs blood. You have the power to save up to 3 lives with your one donation!
