New Beginnings

Advent marks the beginning of a new church year. With all generations who have longed for difference to be made known in the world, we step into Advent listening for hope. Wild-eyed prophets cry for justice and repentance; a pregnant Mary sings of power disrupted, and humility elevated; and angels announce that a Savior has been born. If you are searching for a new beginning, this is an apt season to listen to the almost surreal Advent claim that a Savior – who brings hope and begins something new – is coming.

This Advent & Christmas we invite you and your loved ones to come and see, come and hear, come and experience this joy-filled message of hope. On Advent Wednesdays, we will sing through this story of hope using the service of Holden Evening Prayer. Sundays in Advent will move us through this story from different vantage points, where other voices hold out hope that God can (and will) intercede in the world. Christmas Eve worship brings us with the Shepherds to Jerusalem where we share their hope and joy. Then in January, we join the “three kings” who traverse afar to worship the King of Kings, Lord of Lords, Emmanuel.

Caught up in this hope we can begin to imagine our own new beginnings. These are beginnings that sprout from Good News and push through the Old News, Tragic News, Uneventful News, and even Fake News that fill our lives.

What new beginning will God bring in your life?

What new beginnings will God bring to King of Glory?

Do we dare imagine such hope?

Together, we enter this new year hoping for all that God can and will do in our lives, our church, and our world.

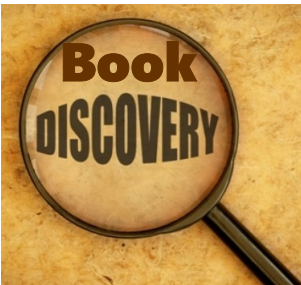


Thursday Bible Study beginning January 3 - 9:30am and/or 7:00pm in the Fireside Room.

Transition Update

A Call Committee of 7 voting members has been selected by the Board of Directors to fill our pastoral vacancy. As you know, Pastors Jen and Ben have expressed interest in a Co-Lead Pastor arrangement and both feel called to become Lead Pastors at King of Glory. Prs. Ben and Jen will be considered prior to proceeding with any discussion or interview with outside candidates.

Agreeing to serve on this Call Committee are:

Eric Nord, Michelle Trost, John Hanson, Amy Wiggs, Ted Clark, Amber Goulet, and Becky Bey (Congregational President).

As guided by the Montana Synod of the ELCA, the role of the Call Committee is to recommend to the Board of Directors if these candidates for the Lead Pastor position best fit the needs of King of Glory. Here is what we expect the timeline to look like moving forward:

*Mid-December - the Call Committee interviews Pastor Ben and Pastor Jen

*Between mid-December and early January - the Call Committee makes a decision regarding recommending Pastor Ben and Pastor Jen to the Board of Directors

*Mid-January - the Board makes a decision regarding approval of Pastors Ben and Jen for a congregational vote

*End-of-January - Congregational Vote

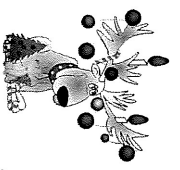
