Fasting and Prayer Guide

Find at least one partner that you can share the things that asking and believing God for in the immediate future. (Those things should include personal matters and matters related to NMCBC). There's nothing too small or too large to ask God for.

- We will pray together as a church family each day at 12 p.m. and 6:00 p.m. via our conference call system. (Monday - Friday)
- There are several options for the fast: (You aren't limited to those, but we want to be on one accord with God and each other as closely as we possibly can). (Saturate this time with prayer and on intent to focus on God).
- * **6:00 am. -6:00 p.m. Fast (only water and juice)** This fast means refraining from eating all food.
- * **Daniel fast (as according to Daniel)** This type of fast generally refers to omitting a specific meal from your diet or refraining from certain types of foods such as no meat and restricting your diet to vegetables and water. (full 21 days)
- * **Ultimately, we should prayerfully determine the thing(s) that we would sacrifice for the sake of a closer walk with God and the showering down of His blessings.**
