



The Pastor's Pen...

Let me share with you some things that are upcoming in the next few weeks here at SABC.

Operation Joseph

Three times a year, in January, May, and September, we collect a financial offering for the people of Venezuela. If you keep up with world affairs, you know that a corrupt leader has run this beautiful country into the ground. People are literally starving to death. Our "Joseph" is Pastor Alberto, a native Venezuelan whom God brought to us, in part, so that he could be a channel through which we could share our plenty with those in Venezuela who have so little. All proceeds go to purchase and ship food there. Already, we have seen needs met, souls saved, and new groups/churches started as God has used your generosity to bring honor to Himself. I encourage you to give as God leads. Make checks out to SABC and note "Operation Joseph" on them. The deadline to give is the end of May.

National Day of Prayer

The annual NDOP is Thursday, May 3rd. All of us can see that our beloved country is in great need of prayer for God to change our direction and heal our land (2 Chr. 7:14). As we do annually, we will participate with believers in our area in two prayer opportunities. At noon, we will gather downtown at the Turnage building to pray. And that evening at 7:00 we will meet at the Dunn Center on the campus of Wesleyan College to pray. I encourage you to be a part of one or both of these prayer opportunities.

Summer Deeper Groups

Last summer, we moved our Deeper Groups into homes for ten weeks.
