The Pastor's Pen...

Did you know that Jesus, when He was on the earth, participated in a Deeper Group of sorts? I'm talking about His disciples. Most scholars believe that for 3+ years, Jesus "did life" with these men as He taught them, fellowshipped with them, encouraged them, challenged them, and so on. Instead of pouring Himself into thousands, He chose to pour Himself into this small group. Why was this His method? I believe one author got it right when he said that Jesus knew He only had a short time and therefore wanted to make sure that at least eleven people (the twelve minus Judas) would carry on His mission after He was ascended back to heaven. He knew if they really "got it," they would multiply themselves. And that's exactly what happened!

So if Jesus is our model, there is much value in a small group. That's why I want to encourage you to sign up for one of our Deeper Groups this summer. For ten Sunday nights, starting June 10, we will meet in homes to "do life" with fellow church members in a home setting. The priority will be to go deeper in discipleship by stressing obedience to the Word. Each Sunday night will center around a discussion of how to apply the Sunday morning message from that day. Hopefully we will "get it" to the point of multiplying ourselves. The home setting always encourages deeper relationships as well. I encourage you to sign up before June 3.

On an unrelated note, I want to inform you that our South Asia mission partnership has come to an end after six years. There are several reasons for that, but I'll mention only a couple. First, our partner church in this partnership, Union Baptist in Ahoskie, recently decided their time in South Asia was completed. It was a stretch for us to meet our obligations there even with a church partner; we could not meet those obligations without their support. Second, it seems as if the Lord has turned our hearts toward Ecuador for this season. We're on track to send four teams this year and I'm excited about our progress there. We saw many good things happen in our six years in South Asia; now we look forward to what God has for us next. We will continue to emphasize Great Commission obedience from our neighborhoods to the nations.

Let's also pray for our student ministry this month as they go on mission in Bulgaria. May God lead them in building relationships there, in sharing the gospel, and in encouraging the church there. I'm so thankful to serve among a missions-minded people. To God be the glory!
