The Pastor's Pen...

As August rolls in, let me mention several key emphases for the month.

The Lord's Prayer Guard: For the past 3 months, 78 of our members have committed to fast and pray for SABC. Lives are being changed as people go deeper in prayer. Susan Arey mentions that through her praying, God has highlighted to her the certainty of His promises, the assurance of His salvation, and the power of His Word. She adds, "Against such weaponry, the enemy doesn't have a prayer." Clint Henry adds, "I sense His Spirit more evident not just in my life, but in that of His church at SABC....He reveals His presence and His will if a person prays sincerely and in desperation for Kingdom things and not just personal, material, or secular gain." Will you join Susan and Clint for the next quarter of the Prayer Guard? We are laying a prayer foundation at SABC upon which the Lord can build His kingdom in people's hearts and we would like to see you working on this foundation alongside of us. Enlistment is coming in August; stay tuned.
