Greetings in the name of our Lord!

As we are now quickly approaching the end of September, we wanted to let you know about a few easy things that you can do to support Trinity. Many of you already know some of these tips, but for all the new families, an introduction may be necessary.

Do you know that we collect Coca-Cola Rewards Codes in the office? Each code is worth between \$.05 and \$.15. (Codes on caps or inside case cartons.) The school receives a quarterly check directly from the company. The more codes we enter, the more money comes to the school. One Trinity Mom turned in hundreds of caps one year and continues to turn them in on a regular basis. Many thanks!



Market Day

Market Day has returned for school fundraising. It is easy to order, and ships directly to your door. Our school receives a percentage of these sales, and the food is quick to prepare and tasty. You can visit MarketDayLocal.com

Recycling used printer ink cartridges at Trinity benefits us as well. When we turn these in to Office Max, we gain credit that is used for copy paper.



Because we believe in being good stewards of our resources, we recycle paper in the parking lot and used batteries in the office. Thank you for helping us and supporting our school!

Also, I wanted to remind you of our Tuition Reimbursement Incentive Program, or TRIP. Many, many families in past years have had hundreds of dollars savings from their tuition payment.

The official title of this program is Great Lakes Script. What is the TRIP program? TRIP/SCRIP is an organization that sells gift card to help non-profits earn money. We promote this program to raise money. This is how it works.

When we get our percentage from SCRIP, we return 75% of that money to the participating parents to help reduce their tuition. Trinity school uses 25% for shipping costs and the tuition assistance fund. When a non-school family purchases cards, 100% of the money is used for tuition assistance. When you purchase gift cards, you get the whole amount on the card + and we receive a percentage back.

It is entirely up to you how much you use TRIP. The more you order, the more money you will earn back. It is an easy program to use. SCRIP online offers credit card usage. You might earn points personally there as well. New last year, is the RaiseRight mobile app. You can sign in with your same ShopWithScrip username and password and access your gift cards right away.

Our next school order is DUE by 9:00 a.m., Monday, Oct. 4. When you order, you are helping Trinity. Go to shopwithscrip.com to get started!

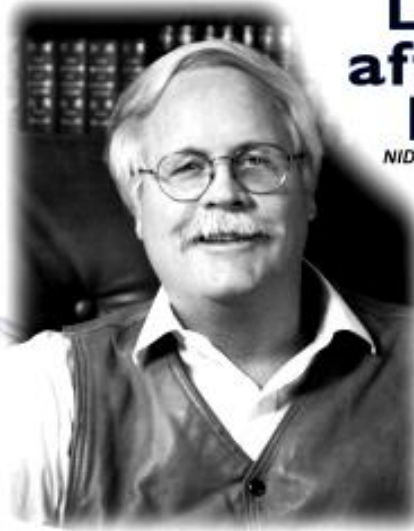

The Carlsons currently reside on a 200-acre farm in Winnebago County and are members of St. Paul Lutheran Church in Rockford, Illinois.

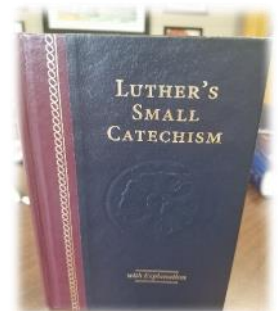


THE LORD'S PRAYER - The Sixth Petition

The LCMS Northern Illinois District (NID) is excited to tell you about *Bringing It For Belize*, a FREE District-wide wellness event taking place the week of October 17-23, 2021. This event focuses on the district's Wellness pillar - Wellness of the members of our district as well as Wellness of the underserved in Belize. It's an easy event in which to participate. All that's required is tracking the number of minutes you exercise during that week, no matter what kind of exercise you prefer. Examples of exercise include walking, running, biking, swimming, jump rope, dancing, and team sports.
