The Christian and Inflation

A trip to the grocery store confirms what you've been hearing on the news: stuff costs more. People who have been around a long time (e.g., me) can remember a time...was it the '80's?...when there was a surge of inflation. No one wants to go back there! Yet, prices in December, we're told, were 7.1% above what they had been a year ago.

The good news is that, maybe, this jump has peaked. Economists are saying that it will steadily decline throughout 2022 and probably end up below 3% by the end of the year. Let's hope so! On the other hand, economists have been wrong before...

None of us like paying more for the things we buy, especially things we can't do without (food, electricity, etc.). Yet, I suspect that the FEAR of inflation is worse than the inflation itself, at least for most of us.

For example, if we bought hamburger at \$3.99 a pound, and it goes up 7%, could we still afford it? It would now cost \$4.26. Probably we could manage that. (Of course, there are people who really are hurt by a 7% increase, and they present a need and an opportunity for us – individually and as a church – to help them in Jesus' name).

But fear has a debilitating effect on us. Anxiety weakens the immune system, can do cardiovascular damage, and cause ulcers and other digestive problems. It can negatively affect our relationships at home and at work.

I suspect fear undermines generosity also. It causes us to be more cautious in our giving, to cling more tightly to what we have, "just in case." Notice that I said fear undermines generosity, not inflation undermines generosity. And fear is a faith issue. Do we believe that God is in control, even of the economy? (He is.) Do we believe that God takes care of us and will provide for us? (He does; He will.)

Naturally, it's true that inflation affects our ability to spend, save, give, and invest. But it does not mean that the sky is falling, or that God has lost control of human affairs.

The theme for our Fall Stewardship emphasis was "Live Courageously!" Inflation is just another one of many things that can cause us to be fearful rather than courageous, and it is just another thing that should drive us to the arms of our omnipotent God. There we will find assurance, comfort, and peace. "Never will I leave you; never will I forsake you," He says (Hebrews 13:5). "My God will meet all your needs according to the riches of His glory in Christ Jesus," St. Paul declares.

Don't let the news chatter about inflation make you anxious! Don't be dismayed by going to the grocery store! (Rather, be thankful for the abundance and selection of merchandise available to us.) Trust God, and continue to live courageously!

Redeeming Life Outreach Ministry

Each year Trinity features a special Life Sunday message and door offering opportunity to support life affirming ministries. This year, Pastor Bob highlighted the opportunity to help the new Lutheran maternity home, Redeeming Life Outreach Ministries (RLOM), as it gets closer to opening in 2022. This will be the first in Illinois, and the first of a national expansion project for this lifesaving and life-transforming ministry. A picture received recently from a birth and baptism announcement helps us to have a small glimpse into the lives saved and share in the hope and joy of their new life in Christ. We look forward to what God has planned here in Illinois! Meet Greysin, born on Christmas Eve at 6 lbs. and 11 oz. Graysin came to the waters of Holy Baptism on February 6th. Following is the quote from Akasha (Greysin's mom) printed on the birth announcement that was recently sent out.

"Having Greysin is one of my greatest accomplishments and so rewarding. I love waking up and caring for him every day. Honestly, if it wasn't for Redeeming Life, I don't know what I would have done. This ministry gave me the support I needed to give him the time and attention he needs from me. I'm really excited about his Baptism, too! I got Baptized during my pregnancy because I wanted to give myself to God. This is the way I want Greysin to start his spiritual life in Christ."

Our door offering is eligible for 100% matching dollar for dollar under the \$1 million life grant opportunity from Synod to support existing and new pro-life mercy projects that help connect families to Word and Sacrament ministry across the country. 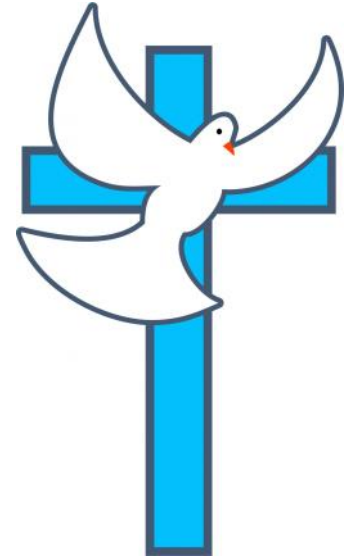
