THE SACRAMENT OF HOLY COMMUNION AT TRINITY

*The Lord's Supper is celebrated in this congregation in the belief and confidence that in this Sacrament,
Christ is truly present, giving us His body and blood, in, with, and under the forms of bread and wine.*

(1 Corinthians 10:16, Mark 14:22-24)

As Christians (and specifically as Missouri Synod Lutherans), we believe that it is through Jesus Christ alone that we have the hope of eternal life. We believe that we are sinners in need of forgiveness and that in the Lord's Supper, God gives that forgiveness, strengthens our faith, and strengthens our union with Him and each other (**Romans 3:23, Matthew 26:26-28**). As Christians, we also believe that as we come to the Lord's Supper, we are making a commitment to amend our sinful lives with the help of the Holy Spirit (2 Timothy 2:19, Romans 8:6).

GUESTS AND VISITORS

Because those who eat and drink our Lord's body and blood unworthily do so to their harm and because Holy Communion is a confession of the faith which is confessed at this altar, any who are not yet instructed or confirmed, or who hold to a doctrinal position differing from that of this congregation and the Lutheran Church Missouri Synod, and yet desire to receive the sacrament, are asked first to speak with the Pastor (**1 Corinthians 11:27-29**). At Trinity we practice Close Communion as adopted by our Synod in Convention.

ALCOHOL CONTENT IN WINE

The "red" wine in the chalice and in the outer rings of the communion cup tray contains alcohol. The "white" wine in the center of the tray is de-alcoholized wine (alcohol nearly 100% removed). You may use the red or white wine in the tray but please remember that the chalice has only "red" wine with normal alcohol content.

TYPICAL QUESTION ASKED BY VISITORS

Q: *Can only LCMS members take communion at Trinity Burr Ridge?*

A: *The Lutheran Church—Missouri Synod has never understood or applies the historic practice of close[d] Communion in such a way as to mean that only LCMS members are permitted to commune at LCMS altars. The official position of the Synod is that not only are members of other Lutheran church with whom we are in altar and pulpit fellowship invited to commune with us, but also that in certain extraordinary cases of pastoral care and in emergencies members of churches not in fellowship with us may be given Communion. The Synod stated, for example, in 1986 "that pastors and congregations of The Lutheran Church—Missouri Synod continue to abide by the practice of close Communion, which includes the necessity of exercising responsible pastoral care in extraordinary situations and circumstance" (1986 Res. 3-08 "To Maintain Practice of Close Communion").*

TRINITY MARCH 2022 COVID UPDATE FROM THE BOARD OF ELDERS

1. We are so thankful that the COVID restrictions are being lifted statewide and within the nation. Effective immediately, you will no longer need to "check-in" at the welcome center in the church narthex. You may register your attendance using the attendance pads located in the pew. As always, if you are not feeling well, please stay home and worship online.
2. The pastor(s) and elders will continue to wear a mask and gloves during Holy Communion in the month of March. However, in April, if all continues to go well in the USA, mask wearing will be optional for them and they will return to washing their hands immediately prior to serving at the Lord's Altar (they will not wear gloves).
3. You may kneel at the communion railing if you desire. There are no restrictions on standing or kneeling. Pastor will bless children who are brought up with you. If you have any questions, do not hesitate to speak with the pastor or an elder (or call the church office at 708-839-1200).

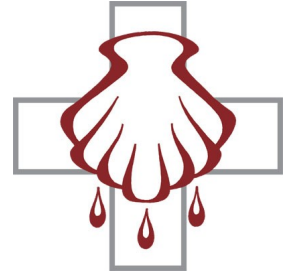

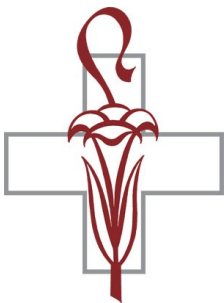
BAPTISM

Making Disciples for Life Seminar Series: Evangelizing the Lost through Life Ministry

In our witness to the sanctity of human life, we often find ourselves engaged with nonchurched people in one way or another. Some of these nonchurched people are pro-life; other are pro-abortion. Some are seeking services or assistance; others are offering help. Some are standing beside us proclaiming the value of life; others are standing against us proclaiming imagined rights. In these various circumstances and encounters, we have opportunities to share the Good News of Jesus with people who are perishing no matter what their view of life may be.
