Local Programs

The Alliance's first Anniversary Church Service was held at Langrum Baptist Church in York, SC. Rev. Dr. Osbey Roddey, church pastor, was the speaker. Subsequently, Anniversary Church Services were held annually at various churches in the Rock Hill vicinity. The second service was at Mount Prospect Baptist Church. The third service was at Boyd Hill Baptist Church. Mount Zion A.M.E. Zion in Lansford hosted the fourth Anniversary Church Service. Other locations for Alliance Anniversary Church Services are Jerusalem Baptist Church in Fort Mill, Union Baptist Church in Rock Hill, Harmony United Methodist Church in Edgemoor, Great Joy Baptist Church in McConnells,

Ebenezer Baptist Church, Nazareth Baptist and Mt. Hebron Baptist Church in Rock Hill.

Dr. Vickie Kerr was the keynote speaker for the Alliance's first Christmas Banquet at Clinton Jr. College in December 1987. On December 16, 1988, Dr. Bertha Maxwell Roddey was the keynote speaker at McBryde Hall at Winthrop University. Other banquets were held at Boyd Hill Center and Northside Center.
