SUPPORT GROUP FOR MOTHERS WITH CHILDREN WHO HAVE SPECIAL NEEDS...

Where: Chelsea First United Methodist Church When: Friday evenings, weekly


Who: the group of mothers, whose children range greatly in age, find strength and comfort in having a non-judgmental circle of caring and understanding. Holding the stories of each mother as sacred is special, honoring work, and is critical to the feeling of trust held by the group members. Two or three facilitators guide the conversation.

"Each week we light our candles after getting something warm to drink and settling into the ambiance of the space. Sometimes someone will have a special sweet or gift to share with others as we go around the circle and reflect on how the past week has been, giving a chance for each woman to get the time she needs to tell her story and have it heard and validated by the others.

We often weave our spirituality into our conversation, do a small writing or art experience to facilitate the Spirit, or read and discuss some of the book we are reading by spiritual director, Kathleen Deyer Bolduc: The Spiritual Art of Raising Children with Disabilities."

ServSafe Class from Chelsea Community Kitchen

Chelsea Community Kitchen is offering another ServSafe Manager training on Saturday, June 24, 2017, for church volunteers who will oversee kitchen activities as well as for restaurateurs and workers. The class lasts 8 hours and has a self study component. Students will receive their books at least one week in advance of the class so they can read it and do the written activities before class time. Class time will include review of the materials and testing. The test will be scored by the National Restaurant Association. Students who pass the test will receive official ServSafe certification that is good nationwide for five years. Fee for the class for church members will be paid for by the church. Family Camp 2017!



Family Camp plans are under way for 2017!
We will be camping this year at Wesleyan
Woods in Vassar, MI. For more information on

Our camping dates are August 10th-13th.

I have reserved a block of campsites as well as 5 cottages.

Campsites will run \$37/night, and do not require a deposit. I do, however, need an RSVP by April 30th, after which any unclaimed CFUMC campsites will be released back to the general public.

Cottages will be assigned on a first-come, first served basis, and you will need to pay a \$50 deposit to CFUMC to secure your cottage rental. Like the campsites, any unclaimed CFUMC cottages will be released to the public after the RSVP deadline, April 30th. Deposits are only refundable until April 30th. Full cost for the cottage ranges from \$55-\$60/night, depending on whether or not your cottage has a microwave/fridge. Cottages sleep from 2-4 people, and there are bathrooms in each cottage.

Dorm rooms will also be assigned on a first come, first served basis, and do not require a deposit. Like the campsites and cottages, any unclaimed CFUMC dorm rooms will be released to the public after the RSVP deadline, April 30th. Cost for the dorm rooms is \$45/family/night. Dorm rooms have 4 bunks (sleeping 8 people) per room, and are in a large building with other rooms and a shared bathroom.

There is NO family activity fee for campers as there has been in years past. All activities (climbing wall, rope wall, wet zip, dry zip, waterslide, low ropes, etc.) are free with the exception of high ropes (\$5) and canoe/kayak (\$45). I intend to reserve the high ropes course for just our group to use on Friday morning, although it can be used at other times with other people outside of CFUMC.

If you would like to camp, please RSVP to Courtney no later than April 30th with the appropriate deposit, number in your party, and equipment you will be bringing (tent, trailer, etc.). Invite family! Invite friends!!
