## Chaperone Guidelines

- Chaperones should comply with the two-caregiver rule as defined by the Safe Sanctuary Policy.
- Chaperones are present for the supervision of the children and youth, and need to remain present with the group. If a chaperone needs to leave the group, he/she needs to check with the other chaperones to make sure there is adequate supervision and enough drivers and seats to transport the children and youth if needed.
- Chaperones should not consume alcohol or drugs while on duty.
- Chaperones who use tobacco should do so away from the group.
- In situations requiring disciplinary actions, chaperones should follow the guidance policy of the church.
- Chaperones should remain mindful that they are representing Chelsea First United Methodist Church and they are role models for the children on the trip.
