Bible Study Basics - New Sunday Morning Bible Study

Do you wish you knew more about the Bible? Do you have trouble understanding some of the passages read aloud in worship? Would you like a place to talk about how the Bible applies to daily life? If you answered "yes" to any of these questions, "Bible Study Basics" may be for you.

This new class will meet on Sunday mornings in March and April from 10:30-11:30 a.m. in Room 207. It will be led by Sondra Willobee, a retired United Methodist pastor. We'll study the scripture passage for the morning services using discussion questions in three different areas:

> What does this passage say? What does this passage mean? How does this passage impact my life?

We'll also talk about the book of the Bible from which the passage comes. This class will increase your understanding of the Bible and enhance your experience of worship. Sondra will send out a discussion guide via email on Thursday of each week. You'll be able to participate better if you think about the questions beforehand. Made for a Miracle: From Your Ordinary to God's Extraordinary New Weeknight Small Group Study

There are two components to every miracle: divine action and human responsibility. Rev. Mike Slaughter is the author of this six week small group study. Together we will explore how we can use our God-given gifts for God's glory. Wednesdays, 6:15-7:15 p.m. beginning March 14.

The United Methodist Church and Conversations about Human Sexuality

At the 2016 General Conference of The United Methodist Church,

delegates approved a proposal from the Council of Bishops to form a commission to explore how the church might live with grace with one another in light of significant differences in LGBTQ inclusion.

Bishop David Bard, invited Michigan United Methodists to gather for listening and discussion - with hearts and minds open to each other and to God's Spirit – about our commonalities, our differences, along with our hopes and dreams for The United Methodist Church. He has encouraged each local church to be engaged in such conversation as well.

In June 2017, we shared in a morning of Holy Conversation, led by Rev. Melanie Carey. Together we sought to deepen our capacity to listen to each other and engage in respectful conversation. In October 2017, Mr. Len Niehoff presented "The Bible and Homo-sexuality." Len gave us tools to foster deeper thinking and better informed dialogue.

Another opportunity for conversation and reflection comes as we learn about The Commission on a Way Forward, which was approved by the 2016 General Conference of our denomination. The Commission is engaged in a complete examination of and possible revisions to every paragraph of the Book of Discipline concerning human sexuality, and exploring options that help to maintain and strengthen the unity of the church. Two 90-minute sessions will be offered (same information, available two separate days/ times): Monday, March 12, 6:30-8 p.m.; Sunday, March 18, 4:00-5:30 p.m.
