Requirements for the use of the facility as public spaces in the midst of COVID-19 pandemic.

You are expected to follow these procedures when you are in the church building, in order to keep everyone as safe and healthy as possible. Thank you for doing your part to keep yourself and others safe.

- **Face masks are mandatory when in the church building**
- The available restrooms are in the hallway off the lobby
- Use the sanitation station (hand sanitizer and sanitizer wipes are supplied)
- The sections of the building currently open for use is the main lobby, hallway, social hall, the courtyard, 206, 207 & 209.
- Maintain at least 6 feet between yourself and others: do not shake hands or touch other individuals
- Cover your mouth and nose when coughing and sneezing; please throw tissues in trash immediately and then wash your hands
- Wash your hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds.
- Per Governor Whitmer's Executive Order 2020-147 (Covid-19) no more than 10 people are in attendance per allotted area of the building.
