Floods in Texas have drastically raised the need for Clean-up Buckets.

These emergency supplies offer immediate relief for flood survivors in what will surely be a long-term flood response.

Contents:

- 5-gallon bucket with resealable lid
 - 5 scouring pads
 - 7 sponges, assorted sizes
 - 1 scrub brush
 - 5 dust masks
 - 50 clothespins
 - Clothesline, two 50 ft. or one 100 ft.
 - 1 box dry laundry detergent, 50-78 oz.
 - 1 pair work gloves
 - 2 pair latex gloves (like Playtex®)
 - 1 liquid concentrated household cleaner (like Lysol®), 12 oz.*
 - 1 bottle liquid disinfectant dish soap (like Dawn®), 25 oz.*
 - 1 pkg. cleaning towels (18 reusable, like Easy Wipes®)
 - 24-count roll heavy-duty trash bags (33-45 gallon)
 - 1 bottle insect repellent (drops or lotion, not aerosol), 6-14 oz.*
- **liquids in plastic bottles only*



Send only new, unopened materials. Pack items securely in the plastic bucket; seal lid with packing tape.
