

## Prayer

- A) Identify a person in your life that does not follow Jesus and that you will bring before God each day
- B) Give thanks for the places where you see God at work in life around you!
- C) Include the corresponding prayer for this week

1/8 Pray for the peace of the world that a spirit of courageous compassion and interconnectedness may move humanity beyond war.

1/15 Pray for our country and our leaders that they may have the courage, honor, and wisdom to rule for peace and wellbeing for all.

1/22 Pray for God's church that it may be a community of faithful transformation where the Holy Spirit calls forth boldness and passion.

1/29 Pray for our enemies, and those who have personally hurt us or betrayed us.

2/5 Pray that our congregation becomes extravagantly generous in giving its time and money to the mission and ministry of God in our church and community.

2/12 Pray for courage to do something that reverses darkness - love someone who is hard to love, serve someone in need, be generous, greet and bless a stranger.

2/19 Pray the courage to carry the cross.

2/26 Pray for the healing and grace of forgiveness for someone who has been made to feel like an outsider.

3/5 Pray for our ministry partners (Chi and Right Steps, Action Ministries) where the poor are cared for, the abused sheltered, recovering addicts respected, and restoration and reconciliation is exercised.

3/12 Pray for yourself, for the grace you need in your life. Confess those areas in your life when you have failed to love God and others as yourself.

3/19 Pray for the community in which we live and that we may be a faithful witness to God's good news.

3/26 Simply be led by Jesus' prayer (Luke 11) to rest in God's presence, beyond words and emotions.

4/2 Pray specifically for someone you know who is far from God. Please list their name and remember them each day.

- 4/9 Let the words of the tax collector (Luke 18:13) guide you into God's presence and rise with the justification that comes through trust.
- 4/16 Pray that God would show you not just how to do servants work, but how you can become a servant among your family and friends and faith community.
- 4/23 Pray that your heart be vulnerable and open to a greater rule from God and love for others
- 4/30 Pray for everyone whose body aches, whose heart is weary or frightened, whose mind is confused, or clouded or cast down. Pray for God's Spirit to fill them with healing and hope and to make us instruments of Christ's peace.
- 5/7 Pray that everyone on our church will find a way to offer themselves for the building up of the faith of Campus View
- 5/14 Pray that our church become one of encouragement, seeking out the gifts of God in the people and structures, so that each can have a heart to serve
- 5/21 Pray that all people will be filled with the Spirit of God and rooted and grounded in love.
- 5/28 Pray for greater Unity, Hope, and Joy at Campus View.
- 6/4 Pray that we can be bold in speaking of Jesus and the difference he makes in our lives. Who is someone we can share a message of prayer or encouragement in Jesus' name this week?
- 6/11 Pray that each person in our church recognize how important it is to the body of Christ for them to be present each week for worship, Bible study, and serving toward unity and building up.
- 6/18 Pray that love can be the impetus and reason for every choice we make at Campus View
- 6/25 Pray for boldness and faith to proclaim Christ in word and deed
- 7/2 Pray for the grace to receive the Spirit, to live by it, and not to quench it in our lives
- 7/9 Recite this daily with your prayers (Eph. 3:14-21) and know the love of God in Christ for you!
- 7/16 Pray for God's Spirit to guide the ministers and leaders of our church to create an environment in which we can grow in love and grace.
- 7/23 Pray for all who seek to follow God in accordance with their true gifts that this may unite us together to honor the sacredness of each person and that we would experience joyful unity amid diversity.

7/30 Pray for our ministry with families of children and youth. Pray that the voices that compete for their attention not overwhelm the voice of God's Spirit to guide them. Bless their marriages!

8/6 Pray for growth in your spiritual life – that you are seeking more fully what God is calling you to be and do.

8/13 Pray that our church may become a place where we become self-emptying like Jesus. How can you look to the interest of someone else this week?

8/20 Pray for all those who are in the dry places in their lives that God's Spirit will renew them in heart, mind, body, and soul.

8/27 Pray for the holiness of our life, that we commit ourselves to simplicity and purity

9/3 Pray for renewal of vision- so that the pursuit of God remains central

9/10 Pray for those that are struggling with addiction and for the anonymous groups that meet in our church to help one another by providing love and accountability.

9/17 Pray for the renewal of the Holy Spirit in your life and the life of Campus View

9/24 Pray for a heart that will be searched, broken, and transformed by God

10/1 Pray for strength and washing to persevere in faith and good works

10/8 Consider the life of Jesus; make a list of those attributes and stories that are most precious to you. Pray for them to come alive in your life in greater measure.

10/15 Pray for the leaders at Campus View

10/22 Pray for those who are homeless or at-risk of homelessness. May we see them as beloved children of God.

10/29 Spend time with God in silence, just practicing a conscious presence and letting Scripture speak to you (Psalm 23, 32, James 3)

11/5 Pray for our brothers and sisters who suffer in body, mind, and soul. Ask for endurance and vision to see opportunity to witness to God

11/12 Pray for the wisdom to know how to take an insult or offense and respond with grace and goodness. Find ways to practice this week.

11/19 Pray for the marriages of our church family.

11/26 Pray for our church to throw away pride and selfishness and dedicate ourselves to brotherly love.

12/3 Pray for God to lead you to a special effort to show love and acceptance and service to a brother or sister in Christ.

12/10 Pray for those who serve behind the scenes – teachers, assistants, maintenance staff, children’s volunteers and more. Find a way to honor them this week.

12/17 Pray that your life can be rooted in deep trust and faithfulness to God this coming year!
