After prayerful consideration I would like to announce the Lord has led me to accept the call to serve as the Executive Director of Living H2O Lutheran Campus Ministry. I assure you that this decision was not entered into casually, nor was it a foregone conclusion.

Our student leaders have developed the mission statement, "Building Relationships, sharing Christ", and I believe that this ministry is about relationships at multiple levels. First our relationship with Christ and our need to share that relationship with all people (Acts 1:8); and then our relationship with each other as partners in the Gospel. (1 Thessalonians 5:12-15) We have a unique opportunity to be the LCMS "mission outpost" to college age students in the metro Omaha area. We provide a home-like environment for our student leaders where they can be supported and grow in their faith, while at the same time being the Lord's hands and feet on campus.

I am just as committed to this ministry and these students as I was over nine years ago when I first began, I would ask for the same level of commitment from you. We have made considerable progress, even while overcoming many obstacles.
