

Important Fifth Grade Information

Go Home Folder:

- Homework and other documents needing parent signature during the week are placed in the "*Bring Back to School*" side of the folder.
- Finished assignments/tests are placed in the "*Keep at Home*" side which means you DO NOT need to return these items to school. ***Please empty this side of the folder weekly!**

Communication Card:

- This card is a part of our Positive Behavior Intervention and Supports (PBIS) and will be sent home in your student's Go Home Folder every Friday.
- The card needs to be reviewed, signed, and returned to school on Monday.
- If the card is not signed and brought back on Monday, the student will get a warning, if it is not signed on Tuesday, the student will get a checkmark and so on.

Reading Minutes:

- 5th graders are required to read 30 minutes 5 times a week.
- Students will record minutes on their monthly reading logs.
- Parents will need to initial/sign minutes weekly.
- Students will be required to total up their minutes at the end of each week & ask for parent signature.
- The reading log needs to be reviewed, signed, and returned to school at the end of each month.

Assignment Notebook:

- 5th graders are required to fill out their assignment notebooks (planners or "agendas") daily.

Expectations

Students will be expected to...

- Meet weekly reading goal & ask parents to sign your minutes
- Fill out assignment notebook daily
- Practice good study habits & be organized
- Follow the classroom's rules.

Parents/Guardians will be expected to...

- Sign students' weekly Communication cards
- Sign student's weekly reading log
- Frequently check assignment notebook
- Check Go Home Folder daily

The Teacher will be expected to...

- Thoroughly explain & model all expected behaviors/procedures
- Keep open line of communication with all parents/guardians
- Provide a safe & comfortable learning environment for each student
- Create a community in which Christ is experienced
