Where would we imag-


ine ingratitude, or unthankful to be on that list? 2 Timothy reveals that being unthankful is a big deal to God. Take a look at the heavy hitters in this verse

This came quite naturally to every child I've ever seen. What we, as parents have had to be diligent about was to teach gratitude. This is a lesson that impacts their whole life, for the good or, if never taught, for the bad.
