I have a better question What is it that you are
praying for in regard to
your soul in 2024? Life
brings its share of concerns with each day that
passes. But how often do
we reflect on the condition of our soul? And
what steps are we taking
in our daily lives to encourage our souls to
flourish to the glory of
God?

John Wesley showed his concern for the soul by encouraging Christians to

ask each other, "How is it with your soul?" In our current culture, it can be easy to neglect our soul.

Psalm 107:9, NKJV

For He satisfies the longing soul, and fills the hungry soul with goodness.

The word longing originally applies to an animal running up and down in search of food or water. God alone can satisfy the cravings of man's spiritual nature. Our soul was made in His image. This means our soul has a yearning that nothing in this world can satisfy. The soul is fallen and therefore has need of restoration which nothing finite can accomplish.

In Thomas Moore's, "Care of the Soul," he begins with these words, which still ring true:

"The great malady of the twentieth century, implicated in all of our troubles and affecting us individually and socially, is 'loss of soul.' When soul is neglected, it doesn't just go away; it appears symptomatically in obsessions, addictions, vinlence, and loss of meaning. Our temptation is to isolate these symptoms or to try to eradicate them one by one; but the root problem is that we have lost our wisdom about the soul, even our interest in it."
