Be Kind by Pastor Sheri Leming

Luke 6:35, NKJV says "But love your enemies, do good, and lend, hoping for nothing in return; and your reward will be great, and you will be sons of the Most High. For He is kind to the unthankful and evil"

We have just celebrated the greatest event in all of history, the death, burial and resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ. I pray we continue throughout our lives to ponder all that He has done for us. It is good to begin each day by considering all that the sacrifice of Jesus means to us and how this should impact the way we walk around this world.

With this in mind, I was reading the above passage the other day. If we read

the whole verse, we see it is quite the tall order. This is the way Jesus walked the earth, and He is our example to follow.

Now as we read this verse. our thoughts may go to a time or two where we actually loved an enemy. But if we study this Scripture, we will see that the tense of the Greek verb implies a perpetual abiding rule of action. Which means, Jesus isn't telling us to occasionally love our enemies, or try to love our enemies. He is describing the way that His sons (and daughters) are to live each day of our lives.

This is going to require more than just attempting to 'do better'. We cannot do this in and of ourselves.

We must rely upon Him and follow His example. He is the example, and pleasing Him because of all He has done for us should motivate us to follow Him...

1 John 4:19, NKJV "We love Him because He first loved us."

I love the end of our text in Luke 6:35 - "For He is kind to the unthankful and evil."

I think we should ask ourselves when was the last time we contemplated the kindness of God? It's easy to be kind to those who are kind to us, but here we read that God is kind to the unthankful and evil. If we're honest, when we come across the unthankful or the evil, we probably feel anything but kind.

Rut Romans 7:4 tells us that "God's kindness is intended to lead you to repentance."

So we read that kindness. like nur shnes, is something we are to put on...

Colossians 3:17

"Therefore, as God's chosen people, holy and dearly loved, clothe yourselves with compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience."

Galatians 5:77-73 lists kindness as a Fruit of the Spirit.

The Greek word for kindness is Chrestos It means a softening of something that was once harsh It describes the kindness or sweetness of temper which puts others at ease, and shrinks from giving pain.

It's good for us to remember God's unmerited favor that He lavishly bestowed upon us, especially in those times when we don't feel like passing along merciful kindness to people who we may feel don't deserve it. We must pray and ask the Holy Spirit to soften our hearts as we respond to those around us. Ask that His Spirit would cultivate Christ in us as we open our eyes to look for opportunities to be kind and fill us with the Fruit of kindness as He has generously and graciously given to us.

Ephesians 4:32, NKJV "And he kind to one another tenderhearted forgiving one another, even as God in Christ forgave you."
