## "He Humbled Himself.." Philippians 2:8 by Pastor Sheri Leming

Resurrection Sunday is coming early this year, Sunday, March 31. This is a time when it is beneficial for us to once again reflect with hearts of gratitude on all that our Savior has accomplished for us, through His life, His death and His resurrection for the remission of our sin.

Philippians 2:8 reminds us that Jesus, "...humbled Himself, and became obedient unto death, even the death of the cross."

"He humbled Himself." Even to the point of death.

'Humble' is not the most popular word in our culture. Winston Churchill once said of his political enemy, "He is a humble man, but he has much to be humble about!" If we are honest, we all could say that we have much to be humble about. This is especially true when we look to Christ. The thought of standing before Almighty God should bring us to our knees.

But being humbled is not something we run to. And even if we find ourselves on that humble road we will find that it doesn't have a lot of traffic. All too frequently humbling is generally what happens to us, as opposed to something we volunteer for. But what does Scripture have to say about this?

James 4:7,10, NKJV "... submit to God... Humble yourselves in the sight of the Lord, and He will lift you up."

1 Peter 5:6, NKJV "Therefore humble yourselves under the mighty hand of God, that He may exalt you in due time"

We are told to humble ourselves. This is what Jesus did in the way He lived His life and in the way He went to the cross. So, what about us?

The spirit of the world in which we are living tells us that we have the right to whatever it is our hearts. or flesh desire...whatever we fancy, that is what we should do or have. And it doesn't matter what Scripture has to say, or even what the morals or ethics of society have to say. It doesn't matter what tradition has been. We are not living in a culture that is inquiring about the "ancient paths".

Jeremiah 6:16, NKJV "Thus says the LORD: 'Stand in the ways and see, and ask for the old paths, where the good way is, and walk in it: then you will find rest for your souls.' But they said, 'We will not walk in it.'"

This mentality has even captured some of our churches. Sadly, there are those who don't want to read what the Word has to say about how to live holy lives, or what we can do to impact the Kingdom of God. Some sermons are focused instead on wants, needs, desires. This often is the way some go about reading God's Word.

J.C. Ryle: "A humble and prayerful person will find a thousand things in the Bible, which the proud student will utterly fail to discern."

E.M. Bounds: "It is only through God's grace that we have been

saved. We must pray that God grant us a submissive spirit and a modest heart."

We humble nurselves when we are willing to take the low place. The psalmist did this when he said, "my sin is always before me." (Psalm 51:3) We can do this because we remember that God exalted Jesus "...to the highest place." (Philippians 2:9) We "humble ourselves" first by submitting to God. When there is a discrepancy between what the world tells us is truth and what the Bible says is truth - we humble ourselves when we submit our understanding to the truth of God's Word. When our desire wants to go contrary to God's commands, we submit our will to God's will. When we don't understand the events that are happening around us, we trust God's providence. "Submit yourselves to God." This is the way

of the Tax Collector as opposed to the way of the Pharisee. (Luke 18:9-14, "...For all those who exalt themselves will be humbled, and those who humble themselves will be exalted.")

Ultimately we must make it a matter of daily prayer as we remember the way Jesus walked before everyone He encountered. It is the way that He obediently continued that walk to the Cross, for us. He humbled Himself.

Dear Lord, I don't want to pray worthless prayers of selfpraise. I pray with the tax collector, "God, have mercy on me, a sinner." Amen

But drops of tears can ne'er repay; the debt of love I owe. Here, Lord, I give myself away; 'tis all that I can do.
