other..." Ephesians 4:32 NIV Last month I ended our April Newsletter article on the subject of kindness with the above Scripture. As I reviewed it, I thought I would use it again for this month. This is the month we celebrate Mother's Day. I cannot look at this verse without thinking of my mom. When Paul and I were very little she would teach us Scripture. But she also would make it fun. as she did everything she touched. One day she was quoting this Scripture, but she added her own thought with it, "Especially to your mother." And to this day, this is what comes to mind when both Paul and I bear this verse.

A godly mother is among the greatest blessings that God can give. Abraham Lincoln once said, "I remember my mother's prayers and they have always followed me. They have clung to me all my life."

The psalmist who penned Psalm 116 as he was recounting all of the benefits that he had received from the Lord, spoke of his gratitude for his mother in verse 16...

"Truly I am your servant, LORD; I serve you just as my mother did; you have freed me from my chains." Psalm 116:16. NIV

The psalmist was writing not only of his thankfulness to God, but also of his great indebtedness to Him. This

struck him so deeply that it made him realize that he owed God more than a simple, "Thank-You!" but he owed his very life for God's service. And he credits his mother for giving him this level of understanding. She taught him not just in word, but in deed. He credits his mother for the way she modeled a life of devotion to the Lord as she devoted her son to the Lord. He wants it to be understood that he had a wonderful mother that trained him for this kind of life. She served her Lord and therefore. He wanted to serve his Lord. And while he is honoring all that his mother did for him in this way, the psalmist is really showing his gratitude to Almighty God.
