Good Tidings of Great Joy by Pastor Sheri Leming

Luke 7:10. NKJV: "Then the angel said to them, "Do not be afraid, for behold, l bring you good tidings of great joy which will be to all people."

The word for glad tidings is also translated from the original language as "gospel"i.e., good spell or good news.

When you think about it, when the church is true to the Gospel of Jesus Christ-it is still bringing the angelic message of Good Tidings of Great Joy!

Charles Spurgeon said. "If the Lord he your joy, your joy will never dry up...I do not think the church rejoices enough. We all grumble enough and groan enough: but very few of us rejoice enough."

Does the word. "gladness" describe our relationship with our Lord?

In Psalm 100:2, we are called to "serve the Lord with gladness come before His presence with singing!" Is this the way we enter into His courts? Is this 'gladness' a reality in our lives? St. Therese is quoted as saying, "May you always experience the joy that comes from putting Christ at the center of your lives".
