The word "retirement" originates from the French word "retirer," meaning "to withdraw," and its use in English dates back to the 16th century, originally in a military context, referring to pulling back or withdrawing troops, also to the "act of withdrawing into seclusion."

last phrase hit you, but when I read. "act of withdrawing into seclusion" it sent shivers up my spine with Covid flashbacks. 

Romans 7:4. NKJV
