For our June Newsletter I would like to echo what I said last month to the mothers in our congregation...

In honor of Father's Day...

I am blessed to know many inspiring men who walk in the fear of the Lord. I dedicate this article to you. You have blessed many lives, and your works indeed do praise you. Thank you for the beautiful example you are to your families, to our community and to Faith Christian Assembly!

I recently read an article

that troubled me. It was written by Jeffrey A. Tucker for the Epoch Times, and it talked about the alarming fact that the modern labor force is missing about seven million men who could otherwise be working. Close to one-third of working age (ages 25 to 54) men have vanished from the labor force. In the 1950s this prime age of men who worked approached 100 percent. Now a third of these men have slipped into a life which is sadly impacting their mental health due to the lack of purpose and

meaning.

As believers we have the conviction that Scripture reveals the best way for us to live. So, considering this, let us look at what God's Word has to say about work:

1 Thessalonians 4:11-12, NKJV, "...aspire to lead a quiet life, to mind your own business, and to work with your own hands, as we commanded you, that you may walk properly toward those who are outside, and that you may lack nothing."

Albert Barnes' commentary explains that Paul is exhorting the Thessalonian church to keep themselves from idle, restless, and dissatisfied lives. The apostle probably took note of the fact that many of those residing in Thessalonica were living slothful lives, and so he insisted strongly on the necessity of being en-

gaged in some useful occupation. The effect of our life of faith is to make us industrious; and every man, who is able, should respond to the sacred obligation to be employed.

God made man to work:

Genesis 2:15, NKJV Then the Lord God took the man and put him in the

garden of Eden to tend and keep it.

He made man to work heartily:

Colossians 3:23, NKJV "And whatever you do, do it heartily, as to the Lord and not to men."
