Treasurer's Report Contributed by James D. Pratt, Co-Treasurer

Our budget for 2016 was \$259,000. There were 61 pledges to the general fund for \$150,760 and 1 pledge to Missions designated funds, \$600. Actual income and expenses for the year:

Our commitments to mission remain strong with dedicated workers giving time and energy, supplies and prayer to help those in our community, our state and around the world. Our mission giving through Presbytery amounted to \$13,139.00. Our budget called for \$10,991.00. The rest was donated because you chose to give to special needs through Joy Offering (\$530), One Great Hour Sharing (\$786) and Souper Bowl Sunday (\$832).

Our congregation contributed an additional \$600 to the Good Samaritan Fund and \$1,106 was directed solely to local mission work. Working together, giving together, may we spread the love of God wherever we go.
